# How to Get Corporate Account or Wallet Details for Payments

To receive payments into your Corporate Accounts, you need to provide the correct bank or wallet details to your payers. This ensures swift and accurate transactions. There are two ways to access your Corporate account details.

## Method 1: Quick Access from the Accounts Menu

This method provides a fast way to get your account details.

1. Navigate to **Accounts** from the left-hand navigation menu.
2. In the **Corporate Accounts** section, click the **three-dot menu** (  ) next to the account you want details for.
3. Select the appropriate option based on your account type:
  - i. **For fiat accounts:** Select "**Account Details (SSIs)**" to display your account details: BIC, IBAN, Account

Number, Bank Name, Bank Code, and Bank Address

- ii. **For crypto accounts:** Select "**Wallet details**" to display your wallet address.

1. From your **Corporate Accounts** section, click the three-dot menu ( ) → **Account overview** → **Account Details** tab.
2. Here you'll view all available information for your account type:
  - i. **For fiat accounts:** Account Holder, Account Holder Address, Account Name, Issuing Entity, Currency, and
